**June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026 — Body and Blood of Christ**

*Learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart. - Matthew 11:19*

**Reflection:** Pay attention to your food. If “you are what you eat,” then apply that insight to this holiest of communions: we become what we eat.

The best-kept secret of the Church’s understanding of Eucharist is that in eating and drinking the body and blood of Christ, we too are transformed. Just as the power of the Holy Spirit transforms the bread and wine into Christ’s body and blood, so, as we consume his Body and Blood sacramental, the Spirit transforms us more fully into the Body of Christ ecclesial, abiding in each other, brimming with Christ-life, breathing one Spirit.

And then, wholeness restored and hunger satisfied, we are commissioned: “Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life.” the Body of Christ - you, me, us - is sent out to our hungry world. A world where starvation is still being used as a weapon of war and food insecurity haunts even affluent communities. A world hungry for meaning, love, justice, wholeness, joy: for communion.

Having become what we eat, we tremble before what comes next. For we will be broken like bread, a miracle of multiplication of Christ’s energy and love. We will be poured out as wine, so that friend and enemy alike can quaff a bit of joy, and take a first step toward peace.

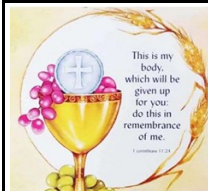

**2026-2027 RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)**

**Date:** starts Monday, July 20, 2026 **Time:** 6 pm to 7:30 pm

**Location:** Christ Our Saviour Parish

**You asked "What is RCIA?"** It is the process through which adults and older children become full member of the Roman Catholic Church. It involves a journey of study, prayer, and liturgical rites, beginning in July and culminating with the reception of Sacraments (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil, and ends in the 1st week of May.

**Purpose:** To introduce prospective converts to Catholic beliefs, practices, and traditions, facilitating a conversion of heart and mind.

**Who It Is For:** 1) Unbaptized adults, 2) those baptized in other Christian traditions seeking full communion, 3) baptized Catholics who have not received Confirmation or First Communion, and 4) for Catholics wishing a refresher course.

**The Process:** It is a journey involving several stages, moving from inquiry to study (catechesis) and spiritual preparation.

**Registration:** if you haven't yet registered but are still considering it for 2026-2027 please contact one of the RCIA Team members asap. Note that late registrations may be deferred to 2027-2028.

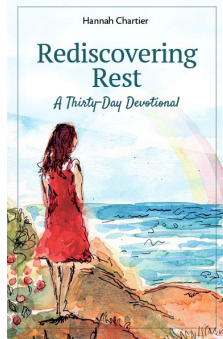
