## May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026 — Most Holy Trinity

He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit". - *John 20:22*

### Reflection:

Trinity Sunday: a feast sometimes misunderstood and often dreaded by preachers. Too often we think of the Trinity as a technical or esoteric doctrine that is somehow disconnected from our everyday lives.

In John's Gospel we are reminded that God is live, a communion of persons that reaches out in history with the offer of friendship and salvation. God the Father declares his love for the world by sending his Son, the Word made incarnate in Jesus Christ, to invite humankind to share in the inner life of God. Christ reminds us that to be created in the image and likeness of God - imago Trinitatis - is to be made for communion with God and neighbour, a calling we are free to accept or reject.

To believe in Christ - to profess our faith in the Triune God - requires something more than intellectual assent to the articles of the Creed. Faith in Christ demands that we are reborn of the Holy Spirit, the spirit of love and truth that binds together Father and Son and that unites us to Christ in his life, death and resurrection. We are called to witness to God's love, not simply by holding up signs emblazoned with the phrase "John 3.16," but rather by living as Jesus did, by serving the mystery of communion with God and neighbour in our daily lives.

**2026-2027 RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)**

**Date:** starts Monday, July 20, 2026 **Time:** 6 pm to 7:30 pm

**Location:** Christ Our Saviour Parish

**You asked "What is RCIA?"** It is the process through which adults and older children become full member of the Roman Catholic Church. It involves a journey of study, prayer, and liturgical rites, beginning in July and culminating with the reception of Sacraments (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil, and ends in the 1st week of May.

**Purpose:** To introduce prospective converts to Catholic beliefs, practices, and traditions, facilitating a conversion of heart and mind.

**Who It Is For:** 1) Unbaptized adults, 2) those baptized in other Christian traditions seeking full communion, 3) baptized Catholics who have not received Confirmation or First Communion, and 4) for Catholics wishing a refresher course.

**The Process:** It is a journey involving several stages, moving from inquiry to study (catechesis) and spiritual preparation.

**Registration:** if you haven’t yet registered but are still considering it for 2026-2027 please contact one of the RCIA Team members asap. Note that late registrations may be deferred to 2027-2028.

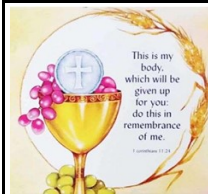
